 - Maximum value is \$6,014,804,859.39
 - Guaranteed Minimum of \$10,000.00 per IDIQ
- Contract type
 - Multiple Award, Indefinite Delivery, Indefinite Quantity (IDIQ)
 - Firm-Fixed Price (FFP) task order CLINs for services and incidental materials associated with the services
 - Time & Material (T&M) for Travel & ODCs
- Evaluation strategy
 - Best Value, trade-off process for IDIQ awards
 - LPTA or Trade-Off process for evaluation of Task Order requirements
- Period of Performance
 - 8 year multiple award IDIQ contracts - 5 year base period, with one 3 year option period

JETS Highlights



- # of Awards:
 - Group A: 14
 - Group B: 22
 - Group C: 19
- Groups can Bid “Up”
- A team can only bid if it has been awarded all of the Task Areas in the PWS
- DLA has no plans to release which vendors were awarded which Task Areas
- RFQ Timeline between 21 and 42 days from receipt of requirement to award (next slide)
- Task Orders may be Best Value, LPTA, or just Lowest Price
- Task Order PoPs will be maximum three years
- DLA will use RFIs when customer requirements and/or acquisition strategy is not fully defined
- Other DoD agencies can use JETS (1% fee or \$100,000 whichever is less)

JETS Highlights (cont.)



- No forecast or plans to release a forecast at this time. RFIs provide the advanced notice.
- Task Orders RFQs may be released as soon as this week
- DLA may use teleconferences with awardees to discuss draft PWSs
- Task Order responses will vary in format:
 - Personnel Summary
 - Resource Allocation by Task
 - Resumes
 - Pricing
 - Technical Volume
 - Management Volume
 - Key Personnel
- Unsuccessful offerors will get notified of awardee and winning \$ value
- OCIs – actual or perceived must be disclosed with each submission.

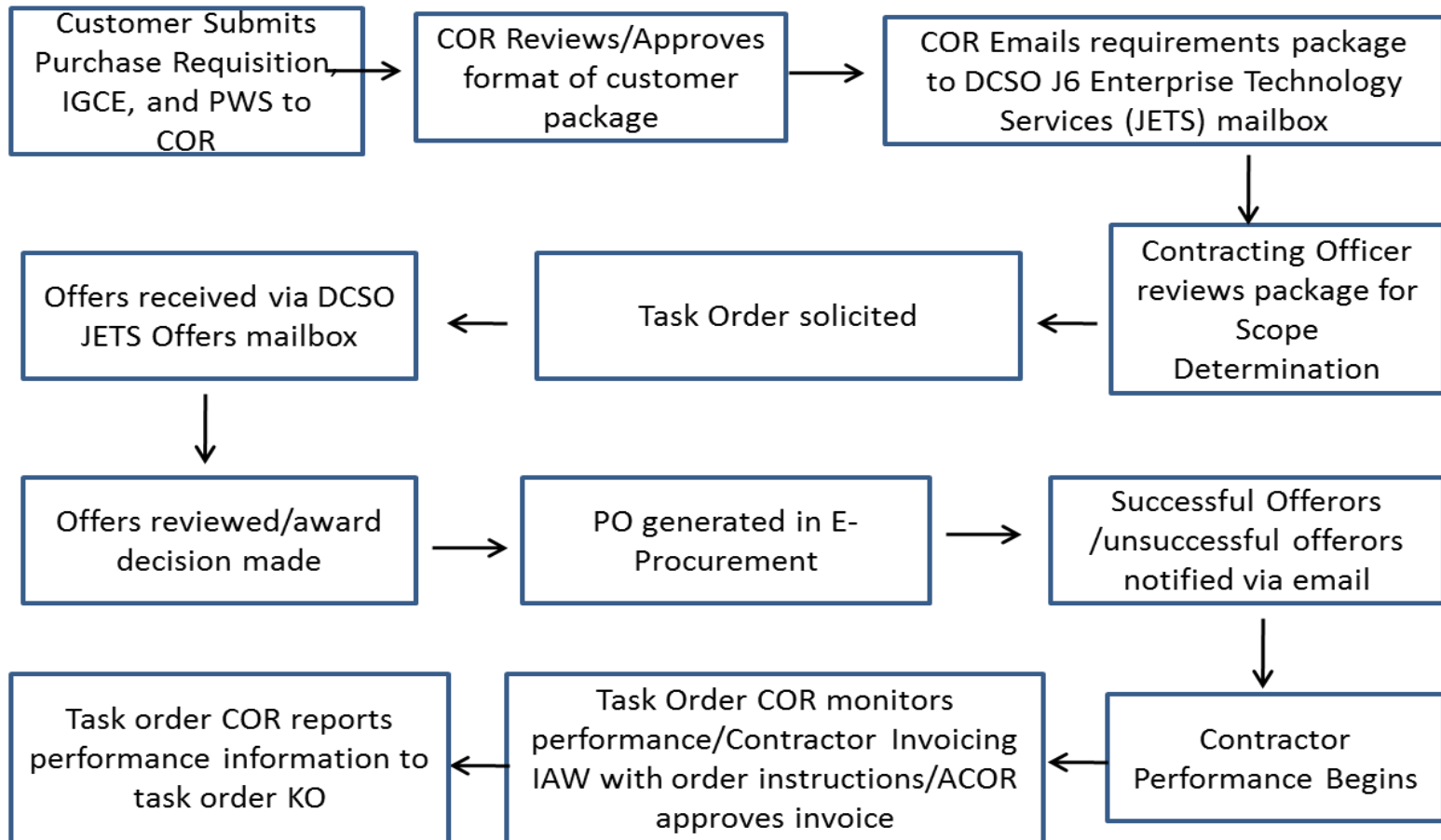

Task Order Competition

- Compete Individual Task Orders (TO)
 - Competition of individual task orders will be in accordance with FAR 16.505(b)(1)
 - Each offeror eligible to compete on the TO Requirements will be given Fair Opportunity to be considered, unless an exception to Fair Opportunity applies (IAW FAR 16.505(b)(2))
 - **Small Business and 8(a) IDIQ holders are not permitted to compete for Task Orders that contain Task Areas that they did not propose at the IDIQ Level**
- Request for Quotes (RFQ) will be sent through email (JETSOoffers@dla.mil) for the individual requirements
 - RFQ's will only be sent to vendors eligible to compete
 - Quote Submissions will require a breakdown of pricing for each TO CLIN and TO Labor Category
 - TO Personnel Summary and Task Allocation may also be required
- Offeror quote submissions will due to the JETSOoffers@dla.mil mailbox by the time and date specified in the RFQ

Task Order Evaluation

- DLA anticipates a 21-42 day turnaround for task order awards (from receipt of requirement to award)
 - Expect quick turnaround on quotations; late is late
- Basis for making a Task Order (TO) award determination will be specified in the RFQ
 - Evaluation may be conducted in accordance with procedures in FAR 16.505(b)(1)
 - Significant factors and subfactors that the Government expects to consider will be disclosed.
 - **May award based on low price, tradeoff, or as otherwise stated in the request for quotes for the task order**
 - Level of effort and mix of labor proposed to perform any specific task will be considered and all prices will be evaluated for reasonableness
- TO Key Personnel will require resume submission for evaluation of resumes
- Price evaluation will validate conformance with Hourly Labor Rate Table pricing and reasonableness
 - When the Service Contract Act applies, any wage determination will supersede established ceiling rates.
